Duties of Data Principals

- In the preceding section, we delved into the rights afforded to Data Principals. However, it's equally important to highlight the corresponding duties incumbent upon them as prescribed by the Act. This segment will elucidate the responsibilities that Data Principals are obligated to fulfill.
- The Data Principals shall perform the following duties, namely;
 - a) Comply with the provisions of all applicable laws for the time being in force while exercising rights under this Act.
 - b) Not to impersonate another person at the time of providing his/her personal data.



Duties of Data Principals

- Not to suppress any material information at the time of providing his/her personal data for any document, proof of identity or proof of address or unique identifier
- The Act gives the Data Principals right of grievance redressal by way of allowing him/her to file complaint
 or grievance with Data Fiduciary or Consent Manager or the Board. However, the Data Principal shall
 ensure that he/she does not register a false or frivolous grievance or complaint with a Data Fiduciary or
 Consent Manager or the Board.
- The Act also provides the right to correction and erasure of personal data to the Data Principals while exercising this right the Data Principal shall ensure he/she only furnish such information as is verifiably authentic.

Duties of Data Principals


• It would be pertinent to note that failure of a Data Principal to carry out any duties under this Act, does not absolve Data Fiduciary from performing his/her obligations under this Act.



Penalty

• Breach in observance of the duties by the Data Principal may result into penalty which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
